

# CALL Protocols for Relaunch of Outdoor Activities

## GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. When the Board has approved the start of certain types of meetings, facilitators **may** start those types of meetings subject to commitments to comply with approved protocols. Facilitators are not required to start, only if they feel comfortable doing so.
2. Be aware that although restrictions are eased, safety precautions must remain in place consistent with Alberta Health guidance (for example, until there is a universal vaccine or effective treatment for the coronavirus.) This is not just for our own health but for the health of the public.
3. Members need to be aware that there are risks associated with in person meetings. Even if you are a registered regular member of a particular group, a member is **not** required to attend.
4. In particular, do not attend an in-person meeting if you have:
  - Any symptoms of the coronavirus or feel even mildly unwell.
  - Have had contact in the last 14 days with someone with COVID-19.

## FACILITATORS

- Keep a record of the names of attendees for two weeks
- Ensure attendees are aware of the facilities (i.e. washrooms) provided at the selected location and the protocols governing those facilities
- In the case of non-compliance remind the person that not following public health orders is against the law and puts people at risk. If the non-compliance is urgent and egregious report to a law enforcement agency.

## ATTENDEES

### PROTECT YOURSELF AGAINST INFECTIONS

- Bring your own hand sanitizer to use after entry (for example opening a gate upon arrival), and after closing the gate upon departure.
- Bring your own water or sports drink.
- Avoid contacting gates, fences, benches, etc.

### PROTECT OTHERS

- Bring a mask and wear it when it is not possible to maintain two meters of physical distancing
- If you sneeze or cough, do so into a tissue or upper sleeve

### DURING ACTIVITY

- Stay at least two meters from others
- Do not make physical contact with other people
- Do not circulate material among group members
- After touching shared surfaces (e.g. gate) use hand sanitizer promptly and avoid touching your face
- When taking a break stay apart from other people

### EQUIPMENT

- Bring and use only your own equipment
- Clearly identify your own equipment if it may be confused with other's equipment
- Do not touch other's equipment with your hands
