

CALL Covid Update: January 2022

Omicron has thrown a wrench into CALL's plans to return to in-person meetings for now, but all is not lost. As a member-led organization we have reached out to ensure we are following your wishes, while always adhering to AHS guidelines of course. **The vast majority of groups have indicated that they will remain on Zoom until things settle down.**

CALL's Processes and Procedures for In-Person Meetings

The Operations Committee has established a process for seamlessly switching from Zoom meetings to in-person meetings when that decision is made, and assuming AHS guidelines permit.

CALL Facilitators should canvass their groups to find out if they would like to return to in-person meetings based on whatever Guidelines are current at the time. (See below) Then the Facilitator will fill out and send a completed Venue Booking Form to their Coordinator indicating that they would like to begin in-person meetings and giving details of where and when. For now, groups are encouraged to follow the schedule that was established for September 2021. Coordinators and Facilitators can access the September Working Schedule for cSpace on the CALL Website under "Resources." The Program Coordinator will check the form and send it to operations@calgarylifelonglearners.ca. Operations will schedule the group and confirm with Facilitators and Coordinators.

This process should provide flexibility so groups can decide themselves when they are ready to meet in person.

Current Guidelines as of January 3, 2022

We operate under the **Restrictions Exemption Program** which means that CALL members must be prepared to show their QR Code to the Group Facilitator or another volunteer who has uploaded the QR Code Reader on a personal cell phone.

In addition, cSpace expects that people will wear masks, distance as much as possible, use hand sanitizer, and keep a list of attendees for at least two weeks.
