

#### PARKING AT VARSITY ACRES PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH:

4612 VARSITY DRIVE NW

There is a parking lot on the west side of the church. It has two entrances, but they do not link up and if there are no spots, you will have to back up to get out.

There is parking on the street along Varsity Drive as well as in the neighbourhood north of the Church. To get there, turn north on Viscount Drive (the street just east of the Church) and drive past the signs that restrict parking (loading zones or parking by permit only) where you will find parking on the streets further away from Varsity Drive.

The parking in the shopping centre across Varsity Drive is reserved for customers during business hours but could be used in the evening. Varsity Community Centre, further east on Varsity Drive, is also a possibility for evening parking, but it may be required for its own activities.

#### PARKING AT cSPACE

1721 29 AVE. S.W

CALL's home is cSPACE, a cultural hub in the historic King Edward School. Most of CALL's activities take place at cSPACE where we lease Room 310.

There is parking on the streets all around the building. There are 36 short-term parking stalls, including two accessible stalls, on the north (29th Ave SW) side of the building. In addition, Marda Loop Community Association has parking that we can access at 310 – 16th St SW about a block away.

#### PARKING AT ROSEDALE COMMUNITY CENTRE

901 11TH AVE NW

CALL groups meeting in the morning are allowed to park on the grass beside the back lane that goes around the green area behind the hall. Absolutely no parking on the lane itself. It's important to park on the east side of the hall rather than the west.

Groups meeting in the afternoon are asked to clear the area by 3:00pm to avoid congestion from school pickups on 11th Ave as the playground exit opposite the hall is designated as the official drop off/pickup area for the school.

#### PARKING AT CRESCENT HEIGHTS COMMUNITY CENTRE

1102 2 Street, NW

Park in the west facing spots **in front** of Crescent Heights Community Centre. This means driving into the students' parking lot and parking in one of the 18 spots directly in front of the building. There are signs at each end of the designated spaces that indicate that the parking is for Community Centre visitors. If you get a ticket by mistake, tell whoever organized your meeting. The Crescent Heights Administrator will be informed and arrange to have the ticket dismissed. The parking spots on the north side of the building are for Curling Club Parking. We can park there when the 18 spaces at CHCC are full as long as there are no curling tournaments taking place and that lot fills up. DO NOT park in any of the student spaces as you could get a ticket from the City which cannot be dismissed.
