Canadians on the Nile Part 1, By Gord Franson Canadians on the Nile Part 2, By Gord Franson


An analysis of the 1978 book "Canadians on the Nile" by Roy MacLaren.

The book is an account of how men from one of the larger colonies Canada, helped to secure one of the lesser dependencies, the Sudan within the realm of Queen Victoria. It will show how rough, turbulent Canadian woodsmen joined with officers and gentlemen and the sometimes equally rough but always brave soldiers of Victoria's army in the most remarkable adventures of the latter half of her long reign.



### Frank Pickersgill - An Unlikely Soldier, by Gordon Fairhead

Frank Pickersgill was a courageous young Canadian whose wartime activities led to his execution at Buchenwald as an Allied secret agent. His early life is portrayed as someone who had poor health and who always felt he lived in the shadow of his older brother, Jack. The rise of Nazism and the war in France drew Frank and a fellow Canadian, Ken Macalister, into joining the SOE. After grueling training, they went to France in June 1943 to help the resistance as they planned to link up with the spy network known as 'Physician'. Unfortunately, by that point the network had been compromised. Sadly, Frank and Ken, along with dozens of other SOE agents, were arrested, interrogated, beaten, and ultimately sent to a concentration camp. On Sept 9, 1944 Frank, Ken and 14 others were hung. The stories of Frank Pickersgil and Ken Macalister are well documented in a book by Jonathon Vance entitled *Unlikely Soldiers*.



The Seven Years War and its impact on native North America, by Henri Walhout.
